## **Edward A. Pence Scholarship**

## **Description**

The Edward A. Pence Scholarship will be awarded each year to one or more graduates of Mt. Vernon Senior High School to further their education at an accredited college or university, or accredited trade or vocational institution.

### **Purpose**

The purpose of this scholarship is the advancement of education by providing financial assistance to one or more graduates of Mt. Vernon Senior High School.

## **Eligibility**

- 1. The applicant shall have attended Mt. Vernon Senior High School, and be in his or her senior year.
- 2. The applicant shall have shown significant academic capability and excellence.
- 3. The applicant shall have consistently demonstrated the personal qualities of initiative, perseverance, leadership, and determination in the pursuit of his/her education.
- 4. The applicant shall intend to matriculate at an accredited four-year college or university in the United States no later than September 30 of the year in which the award is made.

#### Amount

Scholarship(s) will be provided annually from the net income of the Scholarship Fund to deserving students.

## **Payment**

Payment shall be made directly to the university/college specified by the recipient upon proof of acceptance.
