# **Howard Roberts Scholarship**

## **Description**

The Howard Roberts Scholarship will be awarded each year to a Mt. Vernon Senior High School senior who enters a four-year college/university majoring in business by September 30 following high school graduation.

## **Purpose**

To recognize academic excellence and financial need and lend encouragement to Mt. Vernon Senior High School graduates entering business careers.

## **Eligibility**

- A. Have attended Mt. Vernon Senior High School for at least one (1) year.
- B. Be in his/her senior year and expect to graduate from Mt. Vernon Senior High School at the end of the academic year in which the award is made.
- C. Intend to enroll at an accredited four-year college or university in the United States no later than September 30 of the year in which the award is made to pursue a degree in business.
- D. Demonstrate significant academic capability and excellence by having a cumulative B average entering the final semester.
- E. Demonstrate financial need, as evidenced by the completed Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) form which indicates a combined parental income of less than \$75,000 per year.

## **Amount**

\$5,000 as a one-time award the year in which the student graduates.

## **Payment**

Payment shall be made directly to the university/college specified by the recipient upon proof of acceptance.
