Alexander Scholarship 2023

General Information

- A. Scholarship(s) are available for awarding to the graduating seniors in the Class of 2023 at Mt. Vernon Senior High School.
- B. Selection will be made on the basis of academic and leadership achievement and potential.
- C. An Alexander Scholarship will not be awarded to an applicant who has already received a grant or scholarship that would be reduced by this scholarship.
- D. This application and all supporting documents must be in the hands of the Guidance Office at Mt. Vernon Senior High School no later than April 4, 2023 at 3:30 p.m. An application, incomplete in any way, or received after April 4, 2023 may not be considered.
- E. Scholarship recipients making satisfactory progress in college may apply for additional funds the remaining three years of college, with the amount to be determined each year.

Selection Criteria

- 1. Scholarship Achievement (50 points maximum)
 - a. Strength of high school program, considering credits earned and subject difficulty.
 - b. Grade point average.
 - c. SAT scores.
- 2. Leadership Achievement and Potential (30 points maximum)

 - b. Letters of recommendation outlining leadership potential.
