Bostick-Steinmetz Scholarship

Description

The Bostick-Steinmetz Scholarship will be awarded each year to a Mt. Vernon Senior High School senior who enters a four-year college/university majoring in engineering or physical science by September 30 following high school graduation.

Purpose

To recognize academic excellence and financial need and lend encouragement to Mt. Vernon Senior High School graduates entering engineering or physical science careers.

Eligibility

- A. Have attended Mt. Vernon Senior High School for at least one (1) year.
- B. Be in his/her senior year and expect to graduate from Mt. Vernon Senior High School at the end of the academic year in which the award is made.
- C. Intend to enroll at an accredited four-year college or university in the United States no later than September 30 of the year in which the award is made to pursue a degree in engineering or one of the physical sciences.
- D. Have shown significant academic capability and excellence.
- E. Have consistently demonstrated the personal qualities of initiative, perseverance, leadership, and determination in the pursuit of his/her secondary education.
- F. Demonstrate financial need, as evidenced by the completed Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) form.

Amount

Ninety percent of the new income of the trust after payment of operating expenses for the year.

Payment

Payment shall be made directly to the university/college specified by the recipient upon proof of acceptance.
