- Assignments should include material previously taught and not new material. All content areas are expected to post with assignments.
- Swim, art, PE, FACS, Band, Choir will provide a daily activity, practice, or simple project.

- Post assignment via Google Classroom by 10:00am the morning of cancellation.
- Assignment given should take the student approximately 30-40 minutes to complete.
- Assignments given should reflect prior knowledge of information taught (no new material).
- Provide accommodations to those students with IEP's and 504 plans.
- Students will have five calendar days to complete the assignment - Example: February 1st assignment would be due February 5th at 11:59pm.
- If students complete the assignment, a Skyward entry of "Feb. 1st" would be entered into the gradebook (non-score). Enter a "1" for completion, or a "0" for non-completion.
- Teachers are to be available throughout the normal school day to respond to student questions over their assignments.
