As you prepare for your life beyond high school, you will be faced with many important decisions:

- What kind of work do I want to do and how do I find a good paying job?
- Where will I go to college and what are the requirements for admission?
- * What kinds of resources and supports are available to help me after I graduate?

Students ages 14-22, who have an IEP or 504 plan, can get help finding the answers to these questions and many others through the Pre-Employment Transition Services program (Pre-ETS). You also may be able to participate in activities such as:

- * Completing job shadowing to find jobs you like.
- * Developing work skills to help you land a good job.
- * Creating your resume.
- Touring area colleges to learn about majors and admissions requirements
- Identifying financial aid options for college.
- * Learning how to advocate for yourself to get the services and support you need.
